This will provide students with a great opportunity to discover their interests and broaden their knowledge of what is available to them in the workforce.

We invite you to become a guest speaker by making a presentation concerning your career. For more information see guidelines below.

Presentation guidelines: Each presenter will be given a 25 minute-block each presentation. This includes time for answering questions as well as the presentation itself. They may need to present up to three times during the day to students with different grade levels.

The presentation should provide students with a general perspective of your specific career (e.g Hotel management, Real Estate investor) or your general field of expertise (e.g engineering, business) or a combination of both. We prefer that your presentation be in English, but if necessary Thai is also acceptable.

This may include:

- General Interest (e.g why did you choose this job? What do you think are going to be good jobs in the future?)
- Education/and or Training (e.g Does your job change often? How do you update your knowledge and skills? What were your favorite classes?)
- Working Conditions (e.g How many hours a day? Do you work mainly indoors or outdoors?)
- Money (e.g How is your job affected by the economy?)
- Any advice/tips on choosing an ideal career

We encourage you to make your presentation as engaging to students as possible. You are welcome to use a PowerPoint Presentation, provide handouts, give demonstrations or show your finished products or bring extra equipments on Career Day.
